Thinking about applying to be part of the Easter Camp Crew but want to know a bit more info?

Kitchen Crew

Hours - Full time over the weekend based in the onsite EC Kitchen, with breaks in between meals.

Role/Key Duties - Preparing the meals for everyone! Anything from lifting/cutting/chopping/unpacking food etc. The food is served by us and camp parents!

Facilities Care Crew

Hours – Two/Three small shifts throughout the day (this Crew does the least hours - yay).

Role/Key Duties – Cleaning the toilets, showers, water blasting, stocking loo paper etc. This happens while the Main Stage Sessions are on.

Site Safety Crew

Hours – This Crew works in one of three shifts (either morning, afternoon or overnight) each being 8 hours.

Role/Key Duties – Patrolling the site in pairs, stationed at the front gate or active around the site, keeping an eye on wristbands, behaviour, site boundaries etc. Also helping with traffic or people management where needed.

General Crew

Hours – This Crew works in one of two shifts (either morning/afternoon or afternoon/evening).

Role/Key Duties – Setting up/packing down, running and manning the daily afternoon activities programme. Completing multiple rubbish and recycling runs daily. Helping with the Village Stage/evening programme. Being available for odd jobs.

Admin Crew (limited number required)

Hours – Two x4 hour shifts per day, which vary over the weekend of mornings/afternoons/evenings.

Role/Key Duties – Stationed in the onsite EC office dealing with general enquiries e.g. lost & found, where things are around site, programme questions, wristband replacements, selling merchandise etc.

Volunteer Lounge Crew (limited number required)

Hours – Two x 4 hour shifts per day, which vary over the weekend of mornings/afternoons/ evenings.

Role/Key Duties — Positioned in the main building upstairs providing a friendly face for our volunteers and keeping the volunteer lounge tidy and tea coffee and treats supplies stocked up.

Specialised Crews

We also have a bunch of specialised Crews that we need help with over the weekend. That includes Media, Medical, Tech Crews, Prayer Team, chef & catering etc. These all have different shift times and responsibilities that sometimes require previous experience or qualifications.
